

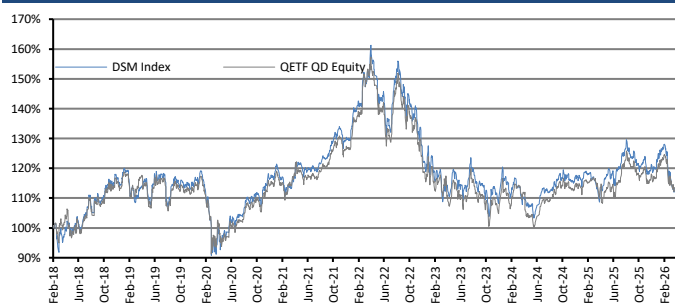
Investment Objective

The QETF is a transparent, liquid and low-cost investment vehicle that offers access to Qatari Equities and the QETF will pay an annual dividend.

Fund Manager's Commentary

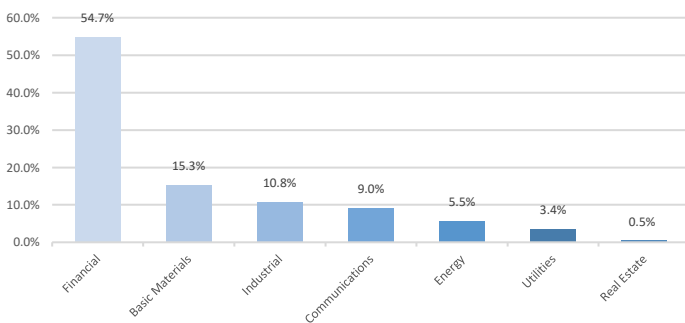
The QE Index declined by 7.84% during the month of March. On a total return basis, the Utilities sector was the best-performing sector, posting a gain of 0.81%. In contrast, the Real Estate sector was the worst-performing sector, declining sharply by 13.93%. Other notable declines were seen in the Energy sector, which fell by 10.97%, followed by Industrials and Materials sectors, down 8.10% and 6.94%, respectively. The Communications Services and Financials sectors also contributed to the overall market weakness, falling by 3.75% and 4.42%, respectively. Lastly, Consumer Staples registered a more modest decline of 2.89%.
