• Improve learning through digital literacy skills among students and engage them learning with technology more meaningfully

• Enhance a teacher's role in engaging with children to develop foundational numeracy and literacy more meaningfully and through creating interest with technology enabled

Program Implementation – May 2022

- Resource Person for the program was appointed in May, and trained on various aspects of the Saksham program
- Summer community mobilization and program began, as planned
- Tablets were planned for purchase in May, but had to be postponed to June due to delays in fund transfer
- Permission for beginning sessions in Ambedkar school from government officials applied for, is expected to be received by third week June
- School will reopen in mid-June and will need 2 weeks for classes to settle down before any new intervention can be taken to schools







Summer Camp Highlights

A summer camp was organised for students at a community learning centre in Worli from 2 to 31 May. An active participation was seen from students and parents.






